School Overview

Arrow Valley First School is a mainstream school with pupils aged 3-9 years. Our community is predominantly White British with below average numbers of students from minority ethnic heritages or with English as an additional language.

Curriculum

At Arrow Valley, we use the Islington PSHE scheme of work as a framework to meet all Relationship and Sex Education statutory requirements. This is a progressive and sequential approach to the learning of key concepts and ideas. It is adapted when required to meet the needs of individual and groups of children. This ensures children can make meaningful links across subject areas and build on existing knowledge and skills. RSE is dealt with honestly and at an age-appropriate level for the children.

Teaching

In most classes RSE will be delivered by your child's teacher, if this is not the case it will be taught by a familiar member of staff who has a strong relationship with the class. Children will be taught at a level accessible to them. In addition, external organisations will be used as and when it is appropriate.

All teachers will ensure they are monitoring RSE carefully to gauge understanding and tackle any areas of concern.
